**Summary of Chapter
Position on Access to and
Extension of Eleven Mile
Road in the Big
Cypress Preserve**

In a resolution sent to the Corps, EPA, DER, DNR, and SFWMD, the Chapter called for strict control of access to Eleven Mile Road in the Preserve, opposed extension and improvement of the road at this time, and called for consideration of alternative methods of access. While recognizing that oil exploration might be conducted in a manner consistent with the purposes of the preserve, the Executive Board felt that the lack of control of access to the road, and proposed improvements constituted a threat to endangered Florida Panthers.
